

# **AKRON MULTI-DISTRICT 1, 2, 3, 4A, 4B, 49, 50, 60**

Minutes from meeting of November 16, 2006

The meeting was opened with the I Am Responsible Pledge and Serenity Prayer at 4:00 pm.

**Secretary's Report:** Jay M. presented the minutes from the October meeting and they were accepted.

**Treasurer's Report:** Gene M. presented the report. Donations were received from Rittman BB Study, Bailey Rd. Closed, North Hill Men's Disc., Cigar Smokers, St. Sebastian, and St. Eugene's Men's Disc. for a total of \$146. Other income was \$7.50 from the October collection & an un-deposited \$25 donation. Expenses included \$78.50 for coffee pots and supplies & rent from the October meeting. Ending checking operating balance was \$631.94 and the Prudent Reserve is \$800. Petty cash was \$106.61. The final balance was \$1,460.05. A distribution from the Akron Intergroup split of \$1,301.39 should be received by the end of November. A **MOTION** to accept the Treasurers' report was seconded and passed.

**Committee Reports:** None.

**Old Business:** The "A Day with Bill W." seminar with Gail L. was discussed. It was decided Gail would do her presentation on the writing of the Big Book, we would have a break for coffee and a presentation on the Multidistrict, followed by the GSO film of Bill W. telling his story. Tentative date is in March. Mike S. was appointed Chair of the committee and Paul K., Tom L. and Gene M. will also serve. Mike will check with City Hospital and Jay will ask Gail for her schedule in order to set a date for the Seminar.

**New Business:** Broad discussion was held for plans for 2007. In addition to the Bill W. seminar, the picnic will be held again in July, we discussed holding another ABC's of Service Seminar, and the possibility of an Old-Timers panel was discussed. Also discussed was an afternoon with 2 speakers, then lunch, then 2 more speakers with an emphasis on service or the Concepts.

There was then a discussion on getting more GSRs involved as well as some of the inactive DCMs in the Multidistrict. Sean will call the DCMs to see if they are still committed to serve.
